Dear Managed Forest Owner;

Following a general enquiry to gauge the interest in an interior forest practices workshop, Council has decided to hold the proposed one-day workshop in the Vernon area on **Saturday July 24, 2010**. The proposed workshop is open to all managed forest owners.

The managed forest inspection program we completed in the past three years has revealed that there are a number of smaller MFs with owners looking for technical advice on a range of topics in managing their properties. It is envisioned that a one-day workshop on an owner's property be facilitated for discussion on technical topics and to assist the owners in networking with other owners.

Suggested topics for the workshop:

- Review Forest Practices Guide *Infolip*
- Harvest Planning Considerations, maps & inventories
- Harvesting options - selective, small clearcuts
- Log marketing – product options, dealing with log buyers specs, value, timing
- Reforestation – regen delay , nurseries / stock types, commercial species selection; selection for disease prevention
- Stand tending – growing for quality, spacing, thinning
- Fire protection – fire proofing, emergency response, neighbours, trespass
- Access- hunters, quads

There will be no charge for the workshop. A confirmation notice will be sent out in June once we have confirmed sufficient registration. Further details such as meeting time and location will be included in the notice.
